- The competition is open to boys under the age of 18 years on the 1st, January, 2010.
- The competition is to be a team event played over the par 3 course of the Edwalton Golf Club. Four players to compete in each team. Each team will be captained by a County junior player who will lead three other junior players, including wherever possible, one 'novice' player who will not have been allocated an official CONGU club playing handicap at the time of entry. Teams will be determined according to a random draw which will be made immediately after the closing date for entries.
- It may become necessary to restrict the number of competitors in the handicap event, in which case entrants will be accepted strictly according to their date of entry.
- Competitors are only allowed to take one prize.
- The entrance fee of £ 5.00 which must be received, at the following address, by not later than 12.00 noon on Monday, the 9th August, 2010, on the specified form attached:

- No entries will be accepted by telephone or after the closing date.
 - The draw and starting times will be communicated to each Golf Club prior to the competition. If a player requires an individual copy of the draw, a stamped, self-addressed envelope must be enclosed with the entry fee and application form.
 - The Committee of the Union reserve the right to refuse an entry of any of the intending competitors.
 - No caddies will be allowed, except in the case of 'novice' players. [Penalty for breach of Condition: 2 strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred. Maximum penalty per round : 4 strokes.]
 - Conforming golf balls: The ball the player plays must be named on the current List of Conforming Golf Balls issued by the R & A Rules Limited. Penalty for breach of the condition: Disqualification.
 - Conforming golf clubs: Driving clubs must not have a characteristic time greater than 257 microseconds when measured on pendulum testing apparatus approved by the R & A Rules Limited. See Appendix II, 5a of the Rules of Golf. Penalty for breach of the condition: Disqualification.
 - Distance Measuring Devices: Players are permitted the use of a distance measuring device for the purpose of measuring distance only. Artificial devices or unusual equipment designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect the play of a competitor [e.g. gradient, windspeed, temperature, etc.] is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.
 - Any points arising in connection with the play will be settled by the Committee appointed for the purpose of this competition whose decision shall be final.
