There has been working group's set up to challenge EG on the matter, I will throughout the year update the clubs on any progress regarding this as I don't think we are at the end of the debate on the matter.

On the domestic front despite it being a very quiet year on the golfing front, I need to thank all the council members for their continued support and wish the President a successful extra year in office.
